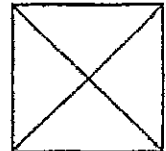


Hello,

Here is the pattern for the Home of the Brave Quilt Block we are using in Texas.

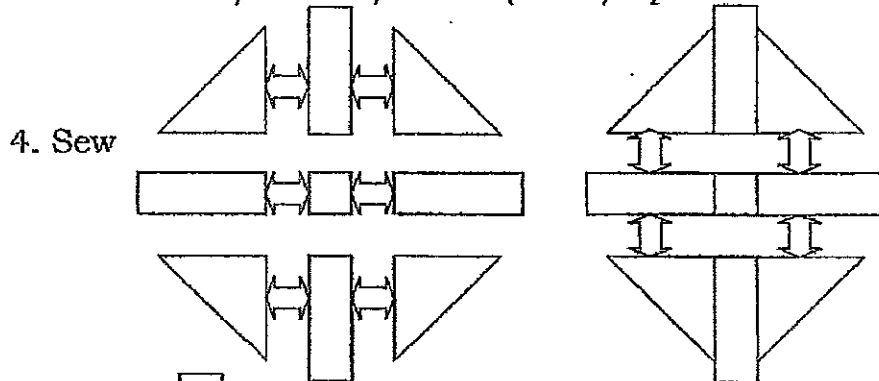
Now, here is an easy way to make this block.

1. I cut an 11 inch square, then cut it corner to corner both ways. Doing this you will get the 4 triangles you need.

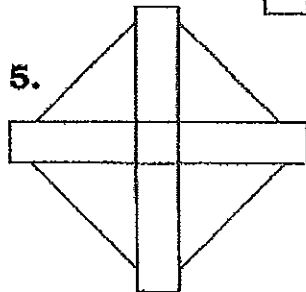


2. Cut 4---2 5/8 X 8 1/2 inch rectangles.

3. Cut 1---2 5/8 X 2 5/8 inch (white) square for the center.

This is what it will look like when you are done sewing pieces together. This is the way I am asking people to give me their blocks. I find that it is better to square up the blocks once I get enough to make a quilt. If you would like, Please sign your name to the center of the block.

Two fat quarters will give you 2 blocks. There will be extra fabric left over.
